Introduction to the Event



The Global Forum on Fighting Corruption is a multilateral meeting. The first meeting of the Global Forum on Fighting Corruption and Safeguarding Integrity between Legal and Safety Employees was held in 1999, in Washington DC, USA. The II Global Forum was held in The Hague, Netherlands, in 2001, while the III Global Forum took place in Seoul, South Korea, in 2003.

The IV Global Forum on Fighting Corruption - From Words to Deeds, will be held from June 7-10, 2005, in Brasilia - Brazil, to discuss practical and effective means for preventing and fighting corruption.

The Global Forum is being organized by Brazil's Office of Comptroller General (CGU), an agency of the Presidency of the Republic, in cooperation with the International Committee, the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC) and "Transparência Brasil" (Transparency Brazil).

Eight workshops and six panels have been developed to promote discussions on issues such as international conventions, money laundering, public procurement, e-government, corruption measurement, conflict of interests, civil society, and corruption at the local level.

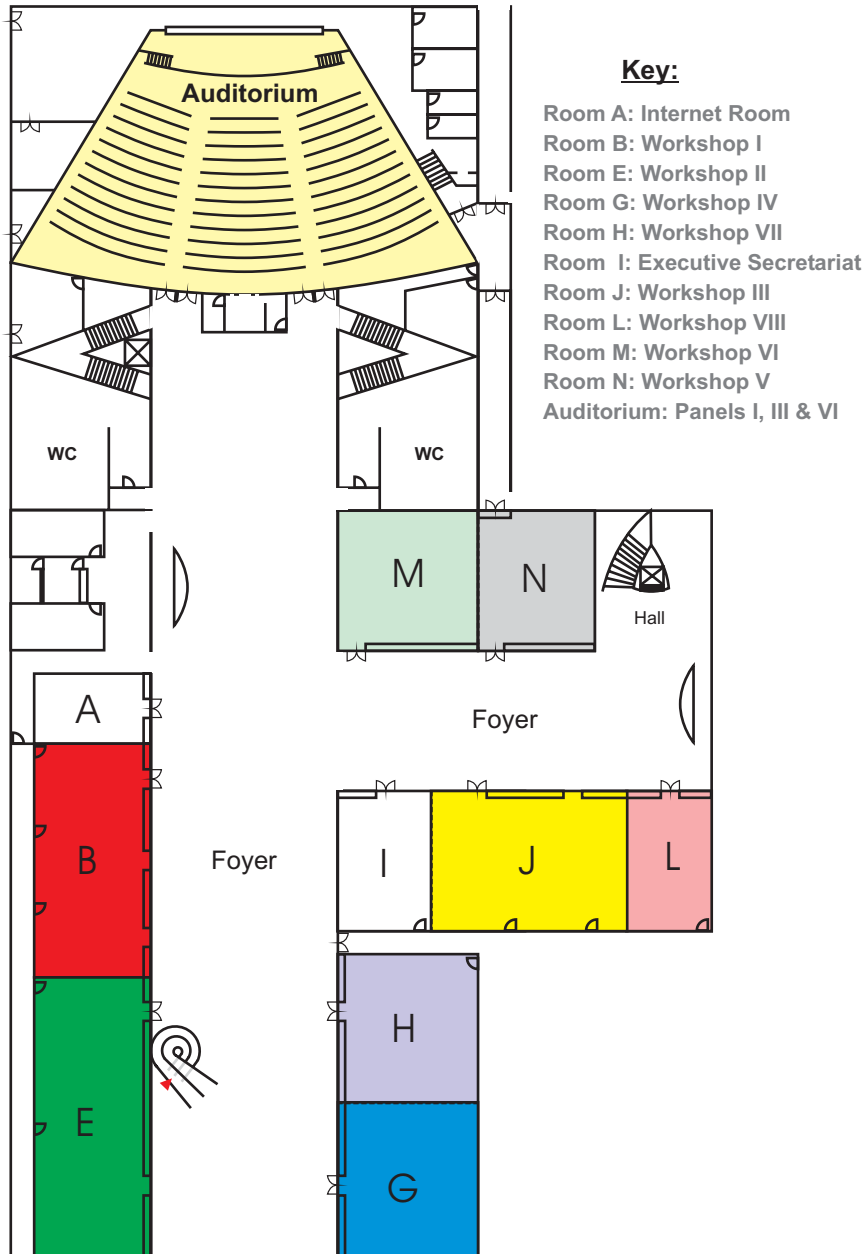

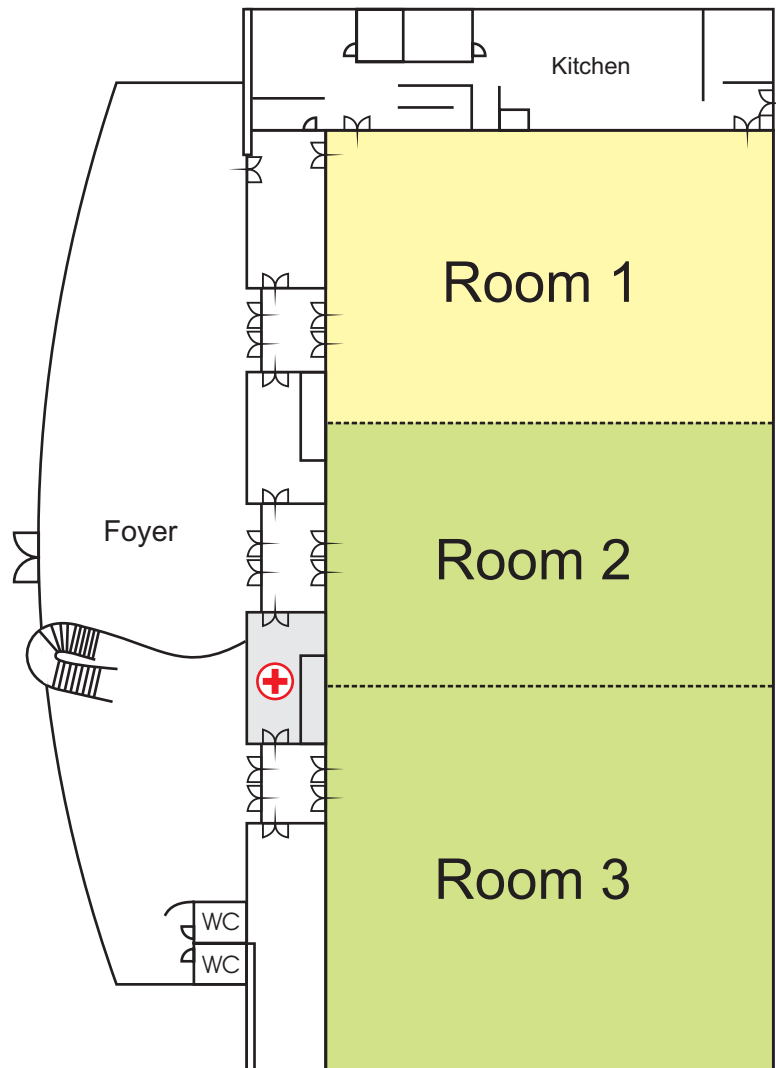

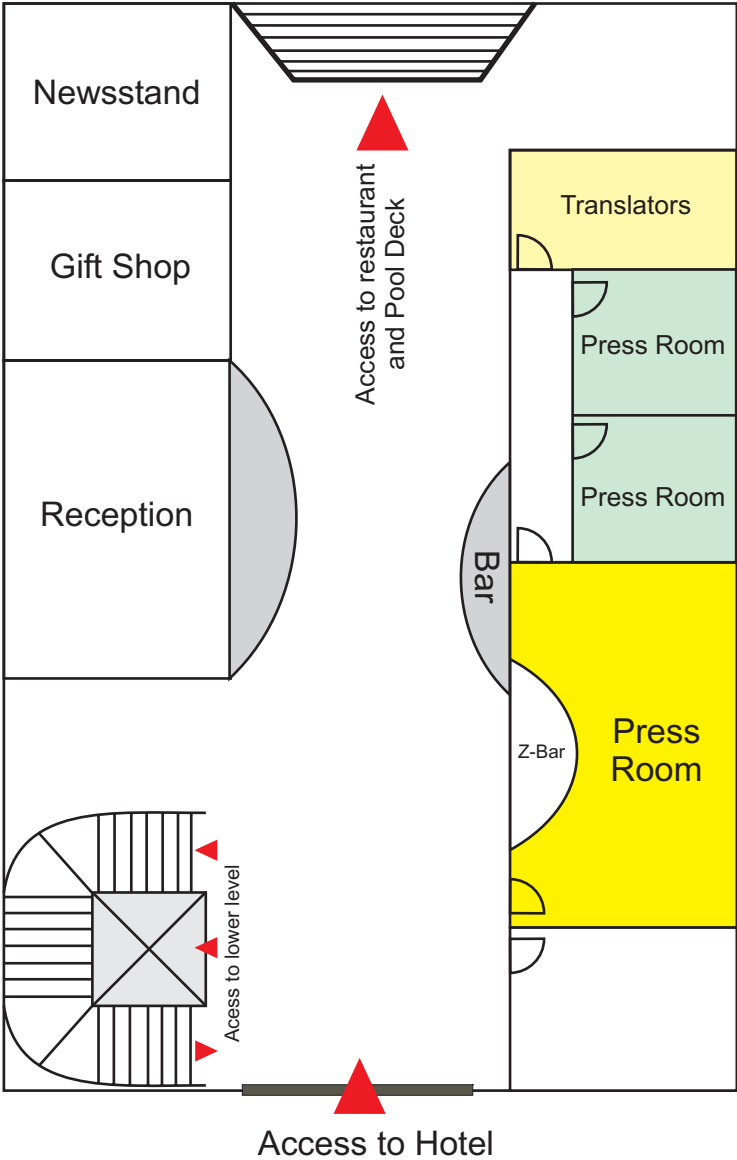
